HISTORY OF THE CONGREGATION

In the middle of the 19th century, Pondicherry mission was an important place for the French M.E.P. missionaries. The situation prevailing then in India was not pleasant. Women were considered as slaves and as second class citizens. Education to the girls was viewed as a curse to the family as well as to the country. The Missionaries were convinced that promoting the education of women was the only way to nurture the dignity of women and to raise the standard of the families.

At this juncture, a synod of priests was held in 1844 for which Fr. Louis Savinien Dupuis drafted the programme. The president along with the Priests spoke emphatically about women education and proposed that a Congregation of indigenous sisters should be started with the responsibility of imparting education to women. This noble and tremendous task was entrusted in the hands of Rev. Fr. Louis Savinien Dupuis who willingly accepted to launch in the vast ocean.

As women education was not thought of in India, Fr. Dupuis had to face innumerable oppositions. Being a man of deep faith in the Divine Providence, a man of understanding, and a man of vision, he faced those oppositions courageously and creatively. After strenuous efforts he started the Congregation of the Immaculate Heart of Mary of Pondicherry on the 16th of October 1844.

HISTORY OF THE SCHOOL

On 02.07.1859, the Second school in the name of Immaculate Heart of Mary was established at Nellithope, Pondy, by the Sisters of Immaculate Heart of Mary Congregation under the leadership of Sr. Susai Annamary. The main aim to begin this school was to impart holistic knowledge to women through education and to sow the seeds of moral values to the children.

In 1863, priority was given to the BPL non-catholic girls to get education and in 1925 Tamil Medium was started. Due to the political unrest and disputes in 1937, there was a sudden fall in the students admission. Later, by the perseverance of Sr. Annabel Mary, the school was recognized as a Middle School by the Government of Pondicherry on 17th August 1970. During this span of time, many poor students benefitted from the school and the infrastructure was extended with new classrooms. In 1980, the building was renovated and extended to accommodate more students. To improve the language skills of the students, English Medium sections were started in 10.06.1981 with 7 students. From 01.06.1985 onwards the staff began to get Government Salary (95%) Again by the continuous efforts of Sr. Annabel Mary, the second floor was built. Our Students began to shine in different fields.

On 1997, under the leadership of Sr. Gnanasoundari, the school was raised to High School level. In the year 2008 vast changes were made in the infrastructure of the school and the building was extended with many classrooms. On 03.02.2010, the school touched the milestone of celebrating its 150th Jubilee Year in a grandiose way. From 2013, modifications were made in teaching and learning processes. Smart Class, Computer Lab with A/c facility were introduced and 6 new classrooms were built.

Today we have reached the fame of getting 100% results continuously for more than 10 years and introducing a novel way of communication system such as SMS, Ex-Curricular activities, Squad system and CCTV.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

FOR STUDENTS:

1. All the students must abide by the rules and regulations of the School.
2. (a) The students are instructed to bring their parents after availing leave to meet the Principal and the class teacher in case of sickness.
(b) Medical certificate must be produced if leave is availed for more than 5 days.
(c) In case of functions prior permission should be obtained.
3. Students are responsible for their personal belongings, such as books, pens, lunch boxes etc. They are strictly forbidden to wear gold ornaments.
4. Students are strictly expected to talk in English in the school premises
5. Students are forbidden from leaving the school premises without the gate pass.
6. Students must not scribble on the walls, doors and furniture with pencil or chalk and they are asked to put the waste paper in the proper place and keep the campus clean.
7. Running, shouting and playing inside the classroom are prohibited.
8. Students should do their assignments everyday without fail.
9. Students should always be smart in complete uniform with two plaits tied up neatly. Identity card is compulsory. In case of loss duplicate identity card must be obtained from the office.
10. Students are expected to take part in all the school activities.
11. Students who involve themselves in malpractice during the examinations will be punished.
12. Students are strictly prohibited to bring electronic devices.
13. Students must bring the answer scripts and Progress cards duly signed by parents within three days.

FOR PARENTS:

1. It is the duty of the parents to take part in all the school activities to co-operate with the management and to take care of their children's behavior.
2. Parents are instructed to watch over the academic progress of their children from the beginning of the academic year.
3. Parents are encouraged to attend the Parent Teachers Meeting and meet the Principal whenever they are called for.
4. Parents are not encouraged to meet the class teachers during the class hours apart from the specific dates.
5. Late comers will not be entertained.
6. Parents must bring the visitor's pass when they come to meet their wards during school hours. Gate pass must be obtained from the office when they take them on permission.
7. Parents must come to receive the progress card of their wards on the specified dates and return it within three days.
8. Parents of class X should send their children for the special study hours whenever informed by the teachers.
9. Parents are not allowed to bring the lunch during break and are instructed to send through the students only.
10. Parents must take care that they will send the X std wards to school for morning special class punctually and without fail.
